



Stainless Steel Potrack PR22 SS

WARNING:

Please read all of these instructions before assembling and using your Pot Rack

Enclosed you will find everything needed for the assembly of your Gourmet Island. Two people working together make assembly much easier. Please unpack, identify and lay out all of the pieces before starting assembly.

Components:

1 – Oval
4 - Hanger arms
1 – Grid
1 – 3/16 Allen wrench
6 – 5/16 x 3/8” Button head screws

Hardware:

2 – Ceiling screw hooks
6 – Grid brackets
12 – EPHS SS Pot Hooks

Assembly and Installation Instructions:

- 1) Please proceed carefully through the following instructions to assure this rack is assembly properly for safe installation and use, and without damage to the finish. Haste in assembly could result in needless scratching or marring of the stainless steel finish.
- 2) Notice that each hanger arm has one hole on one end and two different sized holes at the other end. The end of the hanger arm with the one hole is the end that attaches to the oval. Notice also that two of the hanger arms have a threaded hole at the end with two holes.
- 3) Join the two hanger arms with the unthreaded holes to the two hanger arms with the threaded holes by placing a 5/16 x 3/8” Button Head screw through the unthreaded hole through to the threaded hole in each set. **Leave the screw loose.**
- 4) Place the oval on a flat surface. Next attach the arm sets to the oval by placing them directly over the mounting holes on the oval. Make sure the button head screw at the top of the arm sets are both showing from the same side of the rack. Attach with the four remaining 5/16 x 3/8” button head screws going from the outside of the hanger arms through to the inside of the oval. Make sure that the arm sets are at right angles to the oval and then tighten all screws using the 5/32 Allen wrench provided.
- 5) Place the grid brackets evenly around the oval with the “L” portion of the bracket facing the inside of the rack. Place one grid bracket at each end of the oval and two grid brackets on each side of the oval.
- 6) Gently insert the grid through the hanger arms and onto the grid brackets. Assembly is now complete and your PR22 SS is ready to hang.
- 7) We recommend that you anchor your rack into the solid wood of ceiling joists or beams. Carefully measure the area where the rack is to be hung and install the ceiling screw hooks directly into the wood joists. If it is not convenient to hang your rack directly into wood joists you may use the DRYWALL Toggler anchors not included. The steel anchors are very strong and when installed in drywall will hold 200 lbs. each. Two anchors hold about 400 lbs.
- 8) Hang your pot hooks from the interior squares only. Do not hang them from the perimeter or the cut portions of the grid. Distribute cookware evenly.
- 9) Your rack is manufactured from the finest stainless steel made and has had a brushed finish applied to enhance the beauty and minimize maintenance. Should your rack need cleaning for fingerprints or other stains, we recommend the use of a good quality glass cleaner like “Windex.” Tougher stains can be removed by lightly brushing in the direction of the brush finish lines with a non-metallic abrasive like “**potracks.com** Scotchbrite.”
