# IMPORTANT POINTS

Prior to beginning installation, turn off the cold and hot water lines and open the hot and cold knobs on the old faucet to release build-up pressure.

When installing your new faucet, turn the connector nuts finger-tight, then use one wrench to anchor the fitting and a second wrench to tighten the nut one additional turn. Connections that are too tight will reduce the integrity of the system. Wrap all threaded connections with Teflon tape available at your local hardware or plumbing supply store. Always wrap in a clockwise direction.

All installations can vary depending on how your previous faucet was installed. Not all necessary supplies to install your faucet are included, however, they are available wherever plumbing supplies are sold.

# POINTS IMPORTANTS

Avant de procéder à l'installation, coupez les arrivées d'eau chaude et d'eau froide et ouvrez les manettes d'eau chaude et d'eau froide de l'ancien robinet pour libérer la pression accumulée.



## PUNTOS IMPORTANTES

Antes de comenzar con la instalación, cierre las cañerías de agua fría y agua callente y abra los pasos de agua fría y agua callente del grifo viejo para liberar la presión acumulada.

Cuando Instale su nuevo grifo, ajuste las tuercas de la conexión con los dedos, después utilice una llave para sujetar el accesorio y una segunda llave para ajustar la tuerca una vuelta más. Ajustar demasiado la conexión disminuye la integridad del sistema. Envuelva todas las conexiones roscadas con cinta de teñón. Puede comprar la cinta en su tlapalería o tienda de plomería locales. Siempre envuélvalas en el sentido de las agujas del reloj. Cada instalación puede variar según la manera en la cual haya estado instalado su grifo anterior. Si bien no se incluyen todos los recursos necesarios para instalar su grifo, puede adquirirlos donde se vendan productos de plomería.


- Shut off water supply. Remove old faucet and flexible hoses.
   Clean sink surface in preparation for the new faucet. Flush water connection at home to make sure no debris is stuck in the line.





VIGO warrants the cartridge to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal household use for the period of FIVE (5) years from the Initial date of purchase by the purchaser/end-user, contractor, or builder from VIGO or an authorized VIGO Dealer.

VIGO warrants the finish of the Product to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal household use for the lifetime of the product by the original purchaser/end-user.
