

Installation Instructions

Measure the depth, height and width on the inside of your cabinet. Step 1

The minimum inside cabinet depth required = 10"

The maximum length on the inside cabinet = 36"

Step 2 Mark the upper and lower rails for both the front and rear plate racks to fit the inside width of your cabinet. Use a cut-off saw to cut the rails to proper length.

Cut an Equal amount off each end, keeping the removable dowels centered. **IMPORTANT!** example: to fit a 30" width, cut 3" off each end of a 36" upper and lower rail.

Install the rear plate rack towards the back of the cabinet, keeping it approximately 3" from the back of the cabinet. Step 3 IMPORTANT! Do not mount against the back of the cabinet. Fix the plate rack into position with a brad nail gun, a 3/4" brad is recommended for nailing into 1/2" thick material. (Note: Use caution on nail placement as not to

You must install the plate racks between 7" and 8" apart to accommodate standard plate sizes.

Step 4 Install the front plate rack up against the back of the cabinet frame at the front. (Note: For deeper cabinets you can position the plate rack further back in the cabinet.) Fix the plate rack into position with a brad nail gun, a 3/4" brad is recommended for nailing into 1/2" thick material. (Note: Use caution on nail placement as not to shoot the nail through the cabinet.)
